Under the general direction of the Team Leader, Building and Bylaw Services, the Bylaw Enforcement Officer receives complaints and investigates and seeks resolution to a variety of land use, zoning, restrictive covenant and other CSR D regulatory issues where the CSR D has been made aware of non-compliance with the terms and conditions of those regulations.

Qualifications

- Grade 12 or equivalent supplemented by completion of courses related to Bylaw Enforcement and three (3) years relevant experience in investigation and/or law enforcement work, preferably in a unionized, local government environment; or an equivalent combination of relevant education, training and experience.
- Valid BC Driver's Licence.
