



Local Government Compliance & Enforcement Association of British Columbia 10 & 15 Years of Service Challenge Coin Application

(April 2024, Version 2.0)

The 10 and 15 Years of Service Challenge Coins were developed by the Local Government Compliance & Enforcement Association of British Columbia to recognize those that have served the public in the capacity of local government compliance and enforcement that equals or exceeds a period of 10 and 15 years.

Criteria:

1. "Bylaw Officer" means a person currently employed in carrying out the duties of the compliance and enforcement of local government (including indigenous communities) bylaws;
2. For the purpose of these awards, an applicant must have a minimum of 5 years of service as a Bylaw Officer for the 10 year coin, and 10 years of service as a Bylaw Officer for the 15 year coin.
3. If the periods of service are not continuous or are with more than one employer as a Bylaw Officer, each period of service shall be calculated to the nearest month and the total service shall equal or exceed 120 months for the award of the coins.
4. A maximum of 5 years or 60 months of Other Eligible Enforcement Services as defined in section #10 can be credited towards calculating years of service.
5. Every person who is serving as a Bylaw Officer in British Columbia at the time he/she becomes eligible to receive the coins and every person who has retired or resigned from his/her duties as a Bylaw Officer, but is otherwise eligible to receive the coins, may apply to receive the coins.
6. Every person applying for the 10 & 15 Years of Service Challenge Coin(s) shall be a Regular, Retired, or Life Member in good standing of the Local Government Compliance & Enforcement Association of British Columbia at the time of the application.
7. Active applicants must be a member of the association for the year of application and preceding 4 years (total of 5 years). Applicants that have retired or resigned must have been a member of the association for a minimum of 5 years during their employment.
8. Applications must include contact information of a Supervisor, Director, Department Head/Manager, General Manager, CAO of a local government, or any member of the Executive of the Local Government Compliance & Enforcement Association of British Columbia who can confirm the provided information is accurate.
9. Nominations must be submitted on the prescribed LGCEA form.

10. Other Eligible Enforcement Services include but are not limited to:

- Ministry of Environment Conservation Officers
- Ministry of Forests Natural Resource Officers
- British Columbia Park Rangers
- Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Officers
- Police Officers
- Agriculture Lands Commission Officers
- BC Sheriffs Service
- Bylaw Officer in another province
- Alberta Community Peace Officers
- Other regulatory professions (Eligibility review required by LGCEA Executive)

New Applications:

1. New applications must comply with the listed criteria in section one (1) through ten (10).
2. Applicants with 15 years of service may apply for both the 10 and 15 year coins if they have not already received a 10 years of service coin.
